Annual Reports and 10K Reports

Below is a sampling of different sources for annual reports:

- Annual Report Service – www.annualreportservice.com
 - Free access to full color online annual reports for a variety of companies. In order to use, an account needs to be created first. There is no charge for this service.
- Public Register's Annual Report Service – www.prars.com/cgi-bin/search.cgi
 - Need a full-color copy of an annual report sent to you? This service will mail reports to you at no charge. Company selection is limited, however.
- LexisNexis Database – available through the J&WU library site
 - Search under “Business” and select “SEC filings” to locate a variety of company financial reports including 10-k, 8-k, and annual shareholder reports

 - Free service which provides quick and easy access to online, full-color annual reports.

Business and Company Resource Center - Company profiles include (where available) company histories, chronologies, rankings, financials, investment reports, products and brands, suits and claims, industry overviews, plus links to business news articles. Search for detailed company and industry news and information.

Business Source Premier- Provides full text articles for 2,800 international and scholarly business journals covering management, economics, finance, accounting, and much more. This database is a superb resource for accessing over 10,000 company profiles which are located under the “Company Profiles” tab.

Emerald - Primarily, the full text of management-related articles in various fields including Accounting, Education, Healthcare, Hospitality, Human Resources and Professional Development, Library Services and Information Management, Marketing, Nutrition and Food Science.

General Business File - Analyses of company performance, industry events, and the latest trends in management, economics, and politics. Access trade publications, newspapers, and journal articles.

Hoovers - Includes company profiles, corporate histories, executives, financials and news for 16 million U.S. and international companies. Also includes information about competitive landscape and industry benchmarks.

LexisNexis Academic - News, law, and business information service with full-text access to nearly 6,000 newspapers, periodicals, and reference sources. Company profiles, financial reports, and SEC filings are available under the “Business” section.

Morningstar.com - Company and investment information contained in text, tables, and graphs! Use the “Reports” tab to find a company’s stock quotes, key ratios, financial statements, and annual reports filed with the SEC. “Snapshot” links to a company’s profile, its industry peers/competitors, and financial health. “Analyst Research” includes a “thesis” or opinion about a company with short summaries of a company’s risks, strategy, and management.

Plunkett Research Online - Valuable industry information for students and job seekers in many fields. Each type of industry gives you market research & trends, statistics, company profiles, names of associations within specific industries and occupations, and a glossary of industry-specific terms with their definitions.

Wall Street Journal through ProQuest - Selective, full-text newspaper articles updated daily. Coverage is from 1984 to present; images are not available.

Value Line Investment Survey Investment information service covering some 1,700-equity issues. Every week, about 135 stocks in seven or eight industries are covered. All of the approximately 1,700 stocks and 94 industries are updated in a 13-week period.
